



The results of the competition **combined lifesaving women and men** had to be amended by the Executive Committee of the USPE:

1. The times scored by the members of the 3 x 50 m relay team and the times scored by the individual members of the relay team in their individual competitions were not been added
2. As a result of this rule, all the members of the relay team have to take part and finish the individual event. In the case of Russia, the relay team member Markova did not take part in the individual event, so that there is no team score possible.

***Abridgement of the rules for combined lifesaving***

***“The team score in combined lifesaving will be determined by adding up the times scored by the 3 x 50m relay team and the times scored by the individual members of the relay team in the individual competitions.”***
